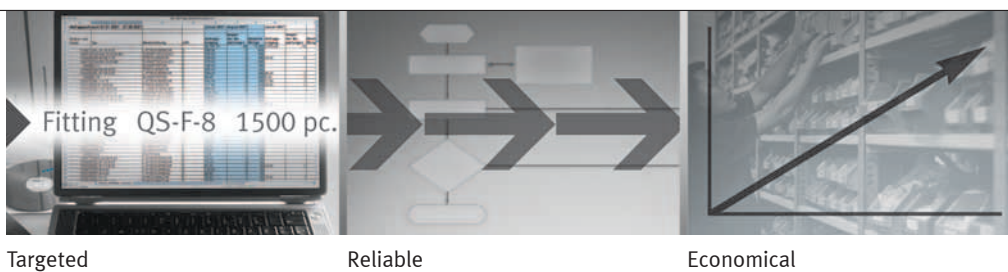

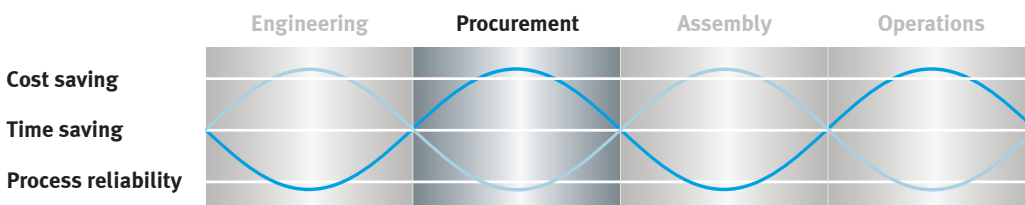
- Warehouse labels with product illustrations make identification easier
